# All aboard the DUCK & HiPPO! TeleChoice organised a Fun Day City Tour & raised funds for children with autism from Pathlight School

SINGAPORE – 2 September 2014 – Staff volunteers from home-grown company **TeleChoice International Limited ("TeleChoice")** took time off from work to organise and participate in the DUCK & HiPPO Fun Day City Tour for children with autism from Pathlight School as part of the company's corporate social responsibility ("CSR") mission.

The Fun Day City Tour which took place over eight days starting from the week of 19 August to 1 September 2014, involved 100 TeleChoice's staff volunteers who took 600 Pathlight School's students ranging from Primary One to Primary Six on board the DUCK & HiPPO for a tour of Singapore's famous city landmarks including Clark Quay, Botanic Gardens, Orchard Road, Little India and Chinatown. Pathlight School is the first autism-focused school in Singapore which offers mainstream academics and life readiness skills.

In addition, TeleChoice's staff raised S\$10,000 with the company matching the amount dollar for dollar, bringing the total amount raised to S\$20,000. The proceeds will go towards sponsoring the 600 Primary School students for their learning journey on the DUCK & HiPPO tour as well as supporting Pathlight School's various programmes such as assistance for poor and needy students.

Mr Vincent Lim, President of TeleChoice said, "Pathlight School has addressed an important need for children with autism and their families in Singapore, and has provided the opportunity to expose them to different experiences so that their potential can be maximised. We are pleased to be able to support their cause. Our motivation for organising this Fun Day is to bring smiles to the children as they enjoy a unique experience together with their friends on the DUCK & HiPPO City Tour. I am heartened by our staff's enthusiasm and like to thank them for responding generously and making the event a success."

This latest project is part of TeleChoice's on-going CSR mission to support community groups and charities through staff volunteerism and fund-raising. Previous projects included Passionatta, a 10-hour continuous relay in aid of Children's Cancer Foundation, and South West Community Development Council's Adopt-A-Rental Block and Home Improvement Project where staff contributed and distributed food hampers and spring-clean the homes of needy families and vulnerable elderly residing in rental flats.
